

GREAT BATTLES OF HISTORY SCENARIOS By David Hughes

This table lists all scenarios published so far in C3i Magazine as well as in the SPQR Guide. They are listed in chronological order (within each Game) and in each case the historic winner is listed before the loser. An = sign separates the two sides in the few inconclusive struggles, while any hypothetical battles are shown by a ? symbol. The level of difficulty can be judged by the number of strength points and maps required. Note that the Simple GBoH rules for 55 of these scenarios are provided in the Battle Manual, which covers those presented in issues 1 to 14 inclusive and in the SPQR Guide. The Simple GBoH rules for the remainder are printed as part of its magazine article. The notes identify those that are best played with counters taken from various modules or even from other games, while a few scenarios have been superseded by a newer version. Modules are abbreviated: Afr = Africanus; Con = Consul for Rome; Diod = Diodochoi; Phx = Phalanx; Phy = Phyrriic Victory; WE = War Elephant. The fortunate owners of the recent Deluxe SPQR Scenario Pack can use it to replace the modules where indicated by a *. In some cases the new leaders needed for a scenario were included with the magazine. However almost all the additional counters needed for the scenarios in #1 to #14 inclusive were provided in the counter set included in the Simple GBoH Battle Manual. From #15 on additional counters were, with a few minor exceptions, included in the magazine's inserted counter set.
